

**Accelerated Bachelor's/Master's Degree (4+1)  
Civil, Environmental & Sustainable Engineering**

The accelerated bachelor's/master's degree program gives undergraduate students the flexibility of taking graduate courses in their senior year and sharing 6 credits on both their undergraduate degree and master's degree. Students are able to complete a Master's degree in one additional year of study.

**Requirements:** Students must have completed a minimum of 75 units of credit towards their CESE Bachelor's degree and have a 3.2 or higher cumulative GPA. Students applying to the accelerated bachelor's/master's degree program are not required to take the GRE (Graduate Record Exam).
