

Pre-admission Credits
For Accelerated Bachelor's/Master's Degree (4+1)
School of Sustainable Engineering and the Built Environment

Pre-admission credits are hours completed before the semester and year of admission to an ASU graduate degree program. With approval of the degree program and the Graduate College, a student admitted to the accelerated bachelor's/master's degree (4+1) may share up to six credits on their bachelor's degree and also on their master's degree. In addition, a maximum of six credit hours of pre-admission credits may be included on the POS for a master's degree provided the credits have not been used in a previously awarded degree program. Only pre-admission credits earned in graduate level courses with a grade of "B" (3.00) or higher may be used towards a graduate degree.
